Tour Sparks Curiosity in How Others Live

Visiting Australia had been on the top of Rachele Bartel's bucket list for several years. Her curiosity was piqued when she saw TourMagination's Australia & New Zealand tour advertised in *The Mennonite*. When she looked over the comprehensive itinerary that spanned several regions of Australia plus New Zealand, it seemed like the perfect opportunity to fulfill her dream.

"I was a little nervous about going with a group I didn't know," says Rachele. Though she has traveled extensively in the US and to Europe with family, she had never gone with a tour group.

Knowing that other tour members had the same faith background made her feel more at ease.

At her request, TourMagination arranged a roommate for Rachele. She and Ceci struck up a friendship as they began emailing each other in advance of the January 30 to February 19, 2015 tour.

Though tour members were from different parts of the US and Canada, they came with a common purpose. "All of us were on the same page, wanting to see these beautiful countries," says Rachele, who is from Kansas. "It was an exciting experience to share with a fun but diverse group."

Rachele was impressed with how well the tour was planned and the balance between group activities and free time. On a free day, she chose to climb the Sydney Bridge—a 3.5 hour experience

that put her 134 meters above the Sydney Harbour. "It was a gorgeous day and the view was amazing," she says. Other tour members chose to visit The Rocks area, where the crafts market was a highlight. "We all had that opportunity to do the things we were passionate about without interfering with others," says Rachele.

At Healesville Sanctuary, Rachele fulfilled more wishes—she interacted with koalas and kangaroos. "The kangaroos reminded me of huge cats. They were mostly indifferent to petting—but if you

had food they were your best friend."

The tour also included many unexpected delights—like watching a colony of the world's smallest penguin parents coming ashore to feed their babies at

dusk on Phillips Island. Rachele was also pleasantly surprised by the beautiful New Zealand landscape. "The destinations were well chosen. Every place we saw had a lot to offer.

There was always something unique."

Rachele tried some new foods including a kangaroo burger, crocodile meat, and the famous yeast-based vegemite spread, which is a traditional Australian survival food that does not need refrigeration. "It's very salty. It is

Amidst her amazing experiences, Rachele was most impressed by the sense of community on the tour: "The thing that stood out was the group interaction and the sharing of stories," she says. In fact, tour members still keep in touch by email. Rachele enjoys remembering her trip by rereading her tour diary.

Though she has not decided where to go next, Rachele says, "I came back energized wanting to see other countries. The tour sparked my interest to want to know how other people live." ●

Travel Refreshes and Transforms

Traveling has impacted my life profoundly. Listening to stories, eating food, worshiping and praying with people around the world has changed me.

The first time I experienced overwhelming hospitality in an impoverished culture was during Mennonite World Conference (MWC) in India in 1997. Janet and I were billeted in a home and our hosts insisted that we take their bedroom. In the morning when we awoke, we smelled fire and heard voices outside the room. Our hosts had heated water for us to take a bath—they brought us a pail of hot water and one of cold. I was deeply moved by their hospitality. They supplied our basic needs when they had so little.

We felt that God had placed us in India for a purpose. Though I was overwhelmed by the poverty in Calcutta, by the smog and people living on the streets, this was one of my deepest growing experiences, spiritually and culturally. It renewed my commitment as a follower of Jesus Christ. At the MWC Assembly, joy in the faces of our brothers and sisters from around the world, the incredible singing, the enthusiastic proclamation of God's word, changed my inner spirit.

Last November, I was privileged to co-lead our Vietnam tour with Luke Martin. Following the morning worship service at the Hoi An Mennonite Church, the pastor asked willing TourMagination

tour members to join him in visiting a number of house churches to encourage the leaders he was mentoring. Six of us joined Pastor Sang along with several of his congregational members as we visited four house churches.

At each gathering, the house church leader and congregation members shared through an interpreter. Then everyone would join hands. Each time Pastor Sang asked me to pray, and Luke Martin interpreted my English prayer. At the last house church, the woman pastor grabbed my arm and said through an interpreter, "I used to hate people like you, because you killed my father." She added, "I worked for the Ministry of Religious Affairs, arresting people like us who are gathered today. But since I became a Christian, since I met Jesus Christ, my sins are forgiven and I can forgive and love you."

This past January, on our tour to Cuba, we had many meaningful encounters. The tour helped destroy misconceptions for tour members and built goodwill with the Cubans we interacted with. Pastor Raul from the Ebenezer Baptist Church in Havana, an Anabaptist congregation and member of Mennonite World Conference, thanked our group of Americans and Canadians for coming. Just a month earlier, in December 2014, President Obama and President Castro had signed an agreement between Cuba and the USA to begin working together.

Pastor Raul said, "Your being here is a kairos [opportune] moment." Our tour members also felt the significance of TourMagination's first trip to Cuba. On her tour evaluation form, a traveler said, "We feel privileged to have participated in this tour. Meeting so many wonderful people, it was a rich, inspirational, educational experience."

Traveling often forces us to rethink the information we have absorbed from living in North America, from our educational system, and from the media. At the end of our tours, we take time for reflection. We usually ask travelers, "What are you going to share when you get home?" And sometimes, as in Cuba, we asked the Cuban Council of Churches, "What do you want us to share with our congregations? How do you want us to pray?" The answer was, "Pray that the leaders we train at our seminary will stay and work in Cuba." So many of the young Cuban Christian leaders were migrating out of the country, yearning for more education, but they were needed at home to nurture the Body of Christ.

Travel refreshes you, transforms your perspective, and gives you energy to be a kinder, more gracious person in your home and in your daily work. As travelers, we also become ambassadors, sharing what we have learned with family, friends, and our church communities. ●
