### **Wed., March 11 San Diego, California, USA**

Embark your ship in San Diego and meet your fellow travellers as you prepare for your adventure.

### **Thurs. & Fri., March 12 & 13 At Sea**

As you travel south, acquaint yourself with the ship's many amenities and activities. Or just relax on deck and enjoy the spectacular ocean views.

### **Sat., March 14 Puerto Vallarta, Mexico**

Acquaint yourself with the charm of Puerto Vallarta. Optional excursions include discovering the countryside on horseback, exploring Puerto Vallarta's beautiful downtown, or going on a Jeep safari ending with time to relax on the beach.

### **Sun., March 15 At Sea**

Continuing south, spend more time enjoying everything your cruise ship has to offer.

### **Mon., March 16 Huatulco, Mexico**

Huatulco's incredible natural scenery will not disappoint. Optional excursions include taking a sailboat through some of Huatulco's beautiful bays, going deep-sea fishing, visiting local homes to get a glimpse into local culture, or going to the Hagia Sophia project which provides regional farmers with productive and environmentally friendly crops.

### **Tues., March 17 Puerto Quetzal, Guatemala**

At Puerto Quetzal, you're perfectly located for access to Guatemala's sights. Optional excursions include visiting Iximche's ancient ruins to learn about Mayan history, exploring the city of Antigua including shopping at a jade museum and factory, or visiting a coffee plantation.

### **Wed., March 18 Corinto, Nicaragua**

Corinto is your gateway to discovery in Nicaragua. Optional excursions include visiting the first botanic garden in Central America, interacting with local children at an educational centre, exploring the Chorotega Museum to see a large collection of pre-Columbian artifacts, or touring charming León.

### **Thurs., March 19 Puerto Caldera, Costa Rica**

At Puerto Caldera (Puntarenas), be introduced to Costa Rica's many attractions. Optional excursions include meeting exotic wildlife at a rescue centre, travelling through the tropical forest canopy by zipline and aerial tram, observing the work of artisans at an oxcart factory, or floating through a mangrove forest to see local plants and animals.

### **Fri., March 20 At Sea**

As you look forward to tomorrow's trip through the Panama Canal, enjoy your cruise ship's attractions.

### **Sat., March 21 Panama Canal Cruising**

The Panama Canal is a monument to the powers of human engineering. Completed over a century ago, it continues to be vital to modern shipping. The canal is considered by some to be one of the 7 wonders of the modern world. Marvel at the canal on your way through from Balboa to Cristobal, as you pass colonial towns, fortresses, and lakes that are home to hundreds of animal and plant species.

### **Sun., March 22 At Sea**

Having traversed to the other side of the Americas, cruise round the northern coast of South America.

### **Mon., March 23 Oranjestad, Aruba**

On the windswept island of Aruba, discover more tropical beauty. Optional excursions include a catamaran cruise along Aruba's coastline at sunset, relaxing on one a white sand beach, visiting a butterfly farm and the incredible Ayo Rock Formation, or snorkeling at reefs and shipwrecks.
